Please read carefully before signing: Acknowledgement, Waiver and Release from Liability (AWRL)

I acknowledge that triathlon is an extreme test of a person's physical and mental limits and carries with it the potential for death, serious injury and property loss. The risks include, but are not limited to, those caused by terrain, facilities, temperature, weather, condition of athletes, equipment, vehicular traffic, lack of hydration, actions of other people including, but not limited to, participants, volunteers, spectators, coaches, event officials and event monitors, and/or producers of the event. These risks are not only inherent to athletes but are also present for volunteers. I hereby assume all risks of participating in and/or volunteering for the Presque Isle Triathlon. I realize that liability may arise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities being released, from dangerous or defective equipment or property owned, maintained or controlled by them or because of their liability without fault.

I certify that I am physically fit, have sufficiently trained for participation in this event and have not been advised otherwise by a qualified medical professional. I acknowledge that this AWRL form will be used by the event holders, sponsors and organizers of this event and that it will govern my actions and responsibilities throughout this event.

In consideration of my application and permitting me to participate in this event I hereby take action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns as follows: I AGREE (a) to learn and abide by the rules/regulations of this event; (b) to waive, release and discharge from any and all claims or liabilities for death, personal injury, property damage, property theft or damages of any kind, which may arise out of or related to my participation including my traveling to and from the Presque Isle Triathlon, the FOLLOWING PERSONS OR ENTITIES: Presque Isle Partnership, Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Bureau of State Parks, Presque Isle State Park, the Presque Isle Triathlon and all other event sponsors, race directors, officers, event producers, employees, volunteers and representatives; c) to indemnify and hold harmless the entities or persons mentioned in this paragraph from any and all liabilities or claims made as a result of participation in this event, whether caused by the negligence of releases or otherwise; d) to not sue any of the persons or entities mentioned above for any of the claims or liabilities that I have waived, released or discharged herein.

I hereby consent to receive medical treatment which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and/or illness during this event.

I understand that at this event or related activities, I may be photographed. I agree to allow my photo, video or film likeness to be used for legitimate purpose by the event holders, producers, sponsors, organizers and assigns.

This Acknowledgement, Waiver and Release from Liability shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law.

GENERAL EVENT INFORMATION

The Presque Isle Triathlon is a nonprofit event. All proceeds will be used to benefit Presque Isle State and the volunteering non-profit organizations whose time/presence contribute to the success of the event.

TIMING. RESULTS. AWARDS. PRIZES. PREMIUM

Timing services will be provided by the *Runner's High* using *ChampionChip Race Timing* technology. Awards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd places will be given in all individual categories and 1st and 2nd places in relay team categories. The awards presentation will be held immediately following the race. A post-race random prize drawing will be held just before the awards presentation. All PI Tri 2011 entrants will receive a custom-designed long-sleeve T-shirt, swim cap, water bottle, and generous post-race food and beverages. **(Note: Late entrants are not guaranteed a T-shirt.)** Finish times will be posted near the timing area as results become available. Complete race results can be accessed the next day at www.runhigh.com.

GETTING THERE

Presque Isle State Park is located approximately 120 miles from Cleveland, Pittsburgh and Buffalo. From I-90 east and west, take I-79 north, exit at West 12th St. Follow West 12th St. west to Peninsula Drive, (Rt. 832). North on Peninsula Drive to Presque Isle State Park. The Waterworks Cookhouse Pavilion is clearly marked and is located approximately 2.8 miles from the head of PISP.

CONFIRMATION

All entrants will be e-mailed with specific information about the race including Presque Isle Triathlon race rules, course map and parking directions.

PI TRI 2011 COURSE DESCRIPTION

PI TRI 2011 will take place exclusively on Presque Isle State Park. The triathlon course design features a nearly complete and scenic tour of beautiful, historic PISP.

0.35 Mile Swim. Well-marked, guarded, open-water swim course in Presque Isle Bay, (near the Water Taxi landing, Waterworks Cookhouse Pavilion area). Throughout much of the swim, water depths will be greater than 6'.

13.0 Mile Bike. One counter-clockwise loop on the main road that encircles PISP, beginning and ending at the transition area near the Waterworks Cookhouse Pavilion. It will be flat and fast. Highest elevation on PISP is 7'.

3.5 Mile Run. Out and back, mostly flat on the multi-purpose trail east of the transition area, finishing near the Waterworks Cookhouse Pavilion.

RACE APPLICATION

- The 2011 Presque Isle Triathlon will be limited to the first 400 entrants. Register Early! Both the 2009 & 2010 Presque Isle Triathlon "sold out" three weeks in advance.**

- Individual entrants may compete in one individual category only and may not also compete as part of a relay team.
- All relay teams must consist of two or three persons. Entries must include all team members' completed application forms, and check/payment for the total entry fee submitted at the time of team race application.
- Relay team applicants may compete in only one team category and only as part of one team.
- Corporate relay team applications must include all team members who are employed by the same company or employer.
- School relay team applications must include all team members who are enrolled in the same middle/high school, college or university.
- There will be a \$5 charge for any/all changes requested including changes to team rosters. This includes any/all changes on race day.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.
- In the unlikely (but possible) weather-related cancellation of the PI TRI 2011, entry fees are non-refundable and will be used first to cover race expenses. All remaining funds will be donated to PIP and the volunteering organization whose time / commitment assisted with the overall triathlon coordination.
