The full-day seminar will be divided into sections that will include some lecture, as well as exercises and discussion. The exercises are designed to help you step out of your comfort zone and experiment in ways that may help you take your images in slightly new directions. discussed although this will not be the primary emphasis of the seminar. There will also be a private Facebook group for a limited amount of time after the seminar where each person can post a certain number of images created from the workshop and receive feedback both from Ellen and from others who attend the seminar.
